5 Factors of Effective Parenting (from SDM)

• Demonstrate parental role

- Model good behavior
- Set clear limits
- Follow through
- o Listen
- Problem Solve
- o Be protective of your child and keep them safe

Demonstrate knowledge of child's development

- Have realistic expectations of your child
- Set age-appropriate boundaries
- o Use age-appropriate discipline, i.e. time-outs, redirection, communication
- o Engage your child in activities such as play groups, Little League, Karate
- o Play with your child

Respond appropriately to child's verbal/non verbal signals

- o Recognize when your child's behavior changes
- Gain an understanding of the cues your child gives, i.e. crying-hungry, hurt, or sad
- Communicate with your child regularly to better understand them
- Ask what is wrong

Put child's needs ahead of your own

- o Feed your child before you eat
- Make sure they have what they need for school
- o Make sure your child is safe in your home

Show empathy toward your child

- Give your child a hug
- Comment on what your child does well-ignore behaviors you don't like to see
- o Encourage
- o Praise
- Comment on and reward positive behavior
